Safety tips, riding tips, and more!

Be Visible

Motorcyclists must take proactive measures to improve their visibility on the road. According to a NHTSA study, 75% of motorcycle accidents result from other drivers not seeing the motorcycle. Employing strategies to enhance visibility is crucial to minimize accident risk.

Be mindful of other drivers' blind spots, areas where motorcycles are difficult to see. Maintain a safe distance from vehicles, especially large ones, and avoid weaving in and out of traffic. Choose brightly colored or reflective clothing to enhance visibility in low-light conditions.

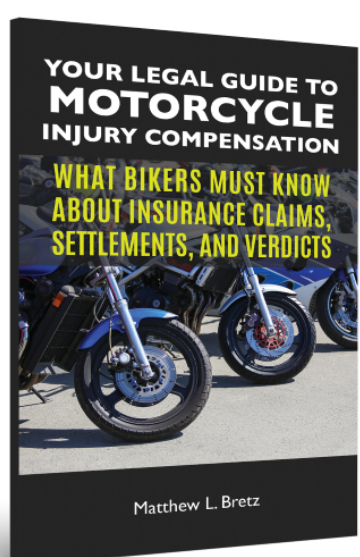

2024 VERGE ELECTRIC MOTORCYCLES COMING TO USA

The Verge TS electric bike, initially unveiled at the 2019 EICMA show, has undergone updates and is showcased at EICMA again. The three models, TS, TS Pro, and TS Ultra, feature Verge's unique hubless rim motor integrated into the rear-wheel rim, providing direct power to the road. The TS claims 107 hp, the TS Pro 137 hp, and the TS Ultra an impressive 201 hp. The hubless motor design allows for a more spare and aggressive look, with the TS Ultra featuring a distinctive nose fairing and solo seat. The bikes incorporate advanced tech, including traction control, regenerative braking, and four rider modes. Verge plans to enter the US market, establishing a headquarters in San Francisco and adopting Tesla's NACS charging connector for fast charging. Deliveries are expected by mid-to-late 2024 for all three models.
