Storing Your Motorcycle for Winter

To protect your motorcycle during winter, start by cleaning it thoroughly and applying wax to prevent rust. Add a fuel stabilizer, top off the tank, and run the engine briefly to circulate the oil and filter to avoid engine damage from old oil.

Inflate your tires to the recommended pressure and, if possible, use a stand to prevent flat spots. Remove the battery, store it in a cool, dry place, and keep it charged with a trickle charger. Finally, cover your bike with a breathable cover and store it in a dry, sheltered spot to keep it ready for spring. By following these steps, your motorcycle will be ready to hit the road as soon as the weather improves.

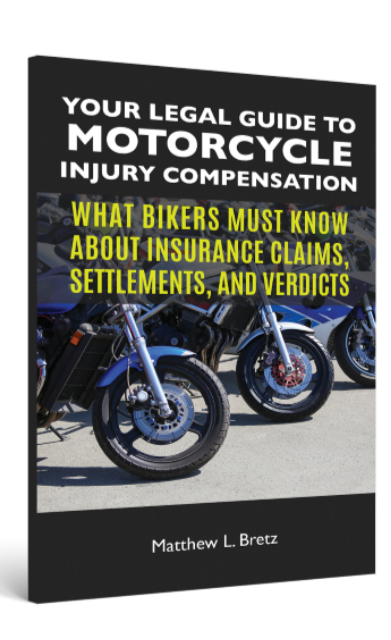
